



## [Getting ready for the EYFS 2021 recording](#)

### Guidance for use

This [recording](#) has been put together to enable you to watch and upskill your knowledge at a time most suitable to you.

It has also been designed, for those settings that employ staff, to be watched as a whole staff team so you all develop your knowledge and understanding at the same time.

If you do not work in a group setting, you may wish to get together with other practitioners from the early years workforce to watch and discuss the key points in the recording.

If you do work in a group setting, we recommend you set aside your next available staff meeting to watch the recording as a whole staff team. This will ensure all staff have the same understanding of the EYFS Reforms and it will enable you to pause the recording when required and carry out the tasks together, further embedding the learning.

If you watch the recording as a whole staff team here are some points to consider:

- If you are leading the staff meeting, we recommend you watch the recording in advance of the meeting so you have a good understanding of what it entails.
- The recording has some pause points where you will be asked to watch a supporting recording or to look at the Padlet or EYFS Guidance. We recommend you have the links to those ready as they cannot be accessed directly through the recording. You may wish to use a second screen to access the PowerPoint from.
- If you are leading the meeting you may wish to decide on some of your own pause points where you can discuss as a team some of the information covered and what this means for you and your setting.

Here are some possible points where you can pause the recording for discussion:

- Slide 5 'The DfE say...' – Choose one of the points listed for discussion.
- Slide 9 'The Unique Child' – How do you consider the educational experience of every child?
- Slide 13 'The Curriculum' – Think about your community and what are the unique needs for your children and families.
- Slide 21 & 22 'How to evaluate your assessment practice' – Discuss some of the points listed, for example, how do you build positive relationships with all children and parents?
