



Leadership and Management Apprenticeships available for Schools in Norfolk

Operations/Departmental Manager – Level 5

- An Operations or departmental manager is someone who manages teams and/or projects, and achieving operational or departmental goals and objectives, as part of the delivery of the organisations strategy.
- Duration: 30 months

Senior Leader – Level 7

- Aimed at Senior Leaders, to help support leading people, setting strategy and culture within an organisation. The broad purpose of the occupation is to provide clear, inclusive and strategic leadership and direction relating to their area of responsibility within an organisation.
- Duration: 24 months

Instructional Coaching Programme Assessor Coach - Level 4

- The AC is a *dual professional*, using their up-to-date professional knowledge and skills to support vocational and professional development across the formal ETS as well as in any employer setting, and at any level.
- Duration: 15 months

Master's Degree in Educational Leadership – Level 7

- Designed specifically for leaders in schools and multi-academy trusts, this apprenticeship brings together leadership expertise from the private, public and third sectors.
- The programme is immersed in educational context while also developing leadership theory and practice that is transferable across sectors.
- Duration 26 months
