Free School Meals

Your child may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are entitled to receive one of the following:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190

Think of the time you'd save

You could save up to **190 hours** a year, which is the time needed to make packed lunches that meet the nutritional standards of school meals – that's just over a week!



Savings for your family

You could save around **£350 per year** if your child qualifies for free school meals.
