

Schools

Children are of school age and attend the school.

Children do not attend the school.

No separate registration required.

You must register on the <u>Early Years Register</u> if children are 0-5yrs (including children in reception).

Register on the <u>Compulsory Childcare</u>
<u>Register</u> if children are between 5-8yrs (Year 1 and above).

Schools may choose to register on the <u>Voluntary part of the Childcare Register</u> if they care for children over 8 years.

Why register?

Registering on the Voluntary part of the Ofsted Childcare Register has several benefits for both the provider and parents:

- Parents will know that the setting has met basic standards designed to safeguard children
- Eligible parents/carers may be able to get help with the cost of their childcare through Tax Free Childcare, tax credit/working tax credit, or universal tax credit and employer supported schemes.
- Local authorities offer support and training to registered providers.
- Childcare providers details are shared through the Community Directory.
- Schools that use an external organisation to provide an extended service are encouraged to work only with registered providers.
