### Key Stage Two Statutory Moderation 2026-27

In recent years we have carried out the KS2 Writing moderation 'visits' in Norfolk, at external venues, rather than in schools.

However, following feedback from schools, starting in the 2026-27 academic year, the process will move away from central venues to an in-school model. This change reflects a deliberate shift towards a more collaborative and context-aware approach, allowing moderators to see assessment practice within the day-to-day environment of each school. By carrying out moderation on site, the process becomes more closely aligned with classroom practice, giving greater opportunity for professional dialogue and shared understanding between moderators and school staff.

### Key Stage Two Tests: How to access results and test scripts

The 2026 key stage 2 (KS2) test results will be available for schools to view and download on the 'Key stage 2 test results and outcomes' page within the 'Dashboard' on the [National Curriculum Assessments Portal \(NCA Portal\)](#) from 7:30am on Tuesday 7 July.

## Key Stage Two Tests: Applying for a review of pupils’ test results

Schools will be able to apply for a review of pupils’ test scripts through NCA Portal from Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July. Further information and guidance is available here: [apply for a review of key stage two results](#).

## Primary Assessment Data Submission

All schools will have received notification through Perspective, to submit their EYFSP, PSC and MTC data to the Local Authority, by the deadlines below. Data should only be provided to the Local Authority using this platform.

The School Data Team have produced detailed [guidance](#), describing the steps required to submit the EYFSP, Phonics Screening Check (including Y2 re-tests) and MTC outcomes.

Friday 19 June	Deadline to submit EYFSP data to the Local Authority via Perspective
Friday 19 June	Deadline to submit Phonics Screening Check data for Year 1 and where applicable Year 2 to the Local Authority via Perspective
Wednesday 24 June	Deadline to submit MTC file results file to the Local Authority via Perspective

Schools should now submit their KS2 Teacher Assessment through the NCA Portal

Friday 19 June	LA recommended deadline to submit KS2 Teacher Assessment data on the NCA Portal
Friday 26 June	DfE Deadline to submit KS2 Teacher Assessment data on the NCA Portal
