Youth Early Support Service - 'YESS' delivered by Prospects, Part of Shaw Trust.

- Deliver Youth Services and work and health programme across Norfolk.
- Nationally, Shaw Trust supports over 80,000 young people per year.
- Last quarter, 98% of young people we supported in Norfolk said that their youth worker listened to them and understood their worries
- Last quarter, 92% of young people we supported in Norfolk said that they have developed resilience and other skills which helped them make positive changes.





## Introducing our Youth Early Support Service (YESS)!

- County-wide offer for 10–18-year-olds.
- Early intervention and support
- **We will recognise young people as experts on their own lives**
- Over 70 young people were initially consulted when designing our programme- However we consult with every Young Person to find out how we can improve it.
- Our support is based in schools

## **YESS TO PROGRESS**

- Working with primary and secondary schools to support young people on their transition.
- Young people aged 10-13, will be offered 6 group work sessions in their primary school
- All will get a follow up visit in high school and some may take up one to one support up to Christmas, if needed.
